ED                    Education (11.5 ft.; boxes 1-26)  
This primary subject category contains material relating to the administration's policy toward bilingual education, the role of education and religion, and concerns over declining educational standards. Material concerning declining standards includes reports created by the National Commission on Excellence in Education, the implementation of the commission's recommendations, Adopt-a-School programs, and adult literacy programs. This primary subject category also encompasses the topics covered in the secondary education subject categories.

DESCRIPTION OF SECONDARY SUBJECT CATEGORIES

ED001	<u>Buildings – Grounds – Libraries – Facilities</u> (0.2 l.ft.; Box 26) This secondary subject category contains material relating to public, private, and university libraries, school facilities, and equal access legislation.
ED002	<u>Scholarships – Fellowships – Grants</u> (0.4 l.ft.; Box 26-27) This secondary subject category contains material relating to private and government-sponsored grants, scholarships, and fellowships. Material is also related to the Presidential Scholars Program administered by the President's Commission on Presidential Scholars, and the Eureka College Reagan Scholars Program.
ED003	<u>Teachers – Teaching Methods – Educational Programs</u> (0.4 l.ft.; Box 27-29) This secondary subject category contains material relating to teacher's concerns about education; merit pay and "Master Teacher" proposals; and teaching methods – particularly in math, science and special education.
